

Prepare For Overnight Camp

Packing Checklist

Sleeping bag or linens for single mattress
Pillow
Two Towels (One for shower, one for water activities)
Toiletries (soap, toothpaste,toothbrush,shampoo, etc)
Socks and undergarments for a week
Two pairs of shoes (one good for activities that can get dirty, horseback riding, hiking, etc)
Water shoes (for the river and lake, avoid flip flops)
Sweatshirt and jeans (in case it gets cold)
Shorts and t-shirts (modest, please)
Rain gear
Plastic bags for wet / dirty clothes
One piece swimsuit (if it's high cut bring shorts to wear on top - tankini ok) / swimming trunks
Bible
Flashlight
For Action Camp Only (ages 13-17)
Clothes for paintball, long sleeves, pants, camo, etc
Water bottle

___ Small pack to hold clothes and towel for the river trip.

Do Not Bring

- Items harmful to your child or others (Knives, weapons, lighters, fireworks, etc.)
- Electronics (collected on first day of camp and returned last)

Drop Off and Pick Up

Monday Check-in is 4:00-5:00 PM Come meet the counselors and settle your camper into their cabin. Camp begins officially with dinner for staff & campers at 6:00pm. Camp gates open at 4:00pm.

<u>Saturday Pick-up is after our Closing Ceremony</u> which begins at 9:45 am. Plan to arrive a few minutes before. Doors open at 9:40 am.

<u>The Camp Store</u> will be open at drop-off and pick-up (cash or card). Funds can be added to camper accounts online during registration or at the store during check-in. Unspent balances will be donated to our Financial Assistance Fund.

Stay Connected

<u>Emails</u> are handed out daily during dinner. Please limit your messages to one per day. Email camper@longviewranch.com with your campers name / day of the week in the subject line.

<u>Care packages</u> may be left in the office to be given out mid-week (no bigger than a shoe box). Great items for a care package are: glow sticks, bandanas, resealable snacks, sports drinks, notes from family members, battery-powered mini spray fans, silly bands. Do not include: any food item that is not in a sealed container, electronics, sling shots, toy guns, etc.

<u>Pictures</u> of camp are posted online during the week. You will be emailed access information once your camp session begins. We make every effort to capture each camper during the week so please be patient with us.

Health Info

Over the counter and physician prescribed drugs will be kept with camp health care staff, and will only be administered by the health care staff. All over the counter and prescription drugs must be in the original container. Parents must turn in medications to the camp office during check-in and claim medications during pick-up.

Policies

- All medical and release forms, plus the remaining balance, are due 4 weeks prior to the starting date of the camp week enrolled.
- Cancellations after June 1, 2025 will be responsible for full tuition. Please notify Longview as soon as possible regarding cancellations to open the spot to another child.
- Campers who must leave due to sickness or emergency will be allowed a refund of \$25 per day not at camp.
- Longview reserves the right to dismiss any camper without refund if their behavior is harmful to other camp participants, our staff, or our facilities.

Other Info

- One camp t-shirt is included in camp tuition.
- Camp videos are free and will be available for download in the fall.
- Longview has a "no electronics" policy during the camp week. Please leave cell phones, mp3 players, gaming devices, tablets, and anything else electronic at home.
- The camp store is open during the week at free time. Campers may bring money with them to spend, or parents can add money to their account during registration online. Items range from \$1-40; snacks are available.
